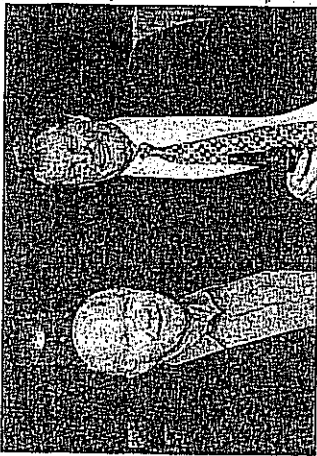

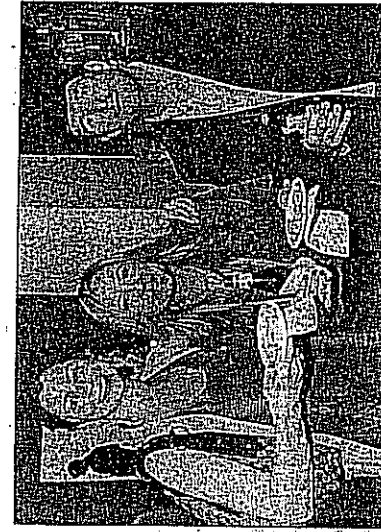

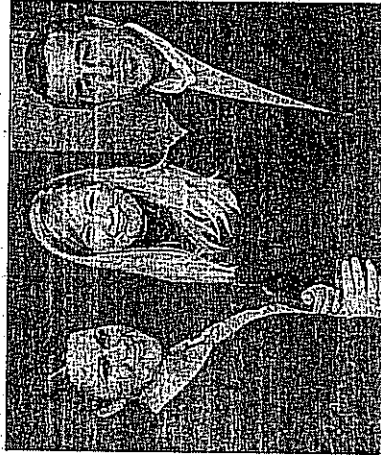
The event: The annual Tinsel and Toddlies event Dec. 11 at McWane Science Center raised \$2,972 for The Lord Wedgwood Charity.

The scene: More than 200 guests were greeted by dancers from the Stevan Grebel Center for Dance. Many entered "Candyland," a room filled with holiday sweets.

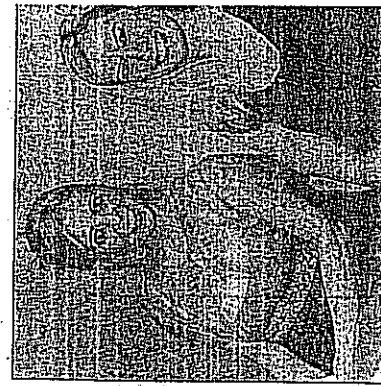
